

AEAS September 2025 Events – Conditions of Scholarship

Melbourne Girls Grammar is offering 10% discount of the first year's school fees and will waive the application fee for students who can demonstrate excellence in a range of learning areas: English, Mathematics or other. Candidates must complete an AEAS test and the online application form complete with:

- 1 x passport details page
- 2 x years of academic reports
- 1 x statement of why they want to study in Australia and what interests them about Melbourne Girls Grammar
- Any certificates or awards received for activities undertaken either at School or within the broader community that demonstrate commitment and individual strengths.

NOTE: AEAS Reports must show the candidate has above-average proficiency across all dimensions of the test. Only students who are seeking to study on a student visa (sub-class 500) are eligible to apply.

Applications for Scholarship consideration should be made at the same time as the candidate registers for the AEAS event or earlier.

Entry can be made for either Semester 1 or Semester 2, 2027.

Candidates must attend the AEAS event in the relevant city so they can be interviewed by Robyn McCutchan, Executive Director Marketing and Community Engagement, in person at a time agreed in advance of the event. Scholarships will be awarded in October 2025.
